Reporting an Emergency

In a life-threatening situation, call 911 for immediate assistance.

When to call 911:

- If someone is injured or ill
- If you see fire or smell smoke
- If you see someone being hurt (e.g., assault, fight)
- If you see a crime in progress (e.g., robbery, burglary)
- If you see a suspicious circumstance that may indicate a criminal activity (e.g., prowler, vandal)
- A vehicle collision, especially if someone is injured

Call quickly! Do not assume someone else has made the call. Try to provide the dispatcher with accurate, detailed information about the problem. Stay on the phone until the dispatcher or police officer tells you it's OK to hang up.
