Day 1: Depart Home — Seattle

Day 2: SPACE NEEDLE — SEATTLE TOUR

This morning, enjoy a Seattle City Tour. Start by visiting the Space Needle, which features an elevator ride to the observation deck 520 feet above the city streets. Built for the 1962 World's Fair, the iconic tower can feature views of the Cascades, Mt. Rainier, ferries, boats, seaplanes & bustling downtown. Next, visit Chihuly Garden & Glass, a monument to glass as art featuring a large portion of Dale Chihuly's work. The long-term exhibition next to the Space Needle features a Glasshouse, an Exhibition Hall with galleries, and a lush garden that serves as the backdrop for glass sculptures made up of impossible shapes and brilliant colors. The city tour continues, featuring historic Pioneer Square and the Chittenden Locks & Fish Ladders. End your tour at the famous Pike Place Market. Built in 1903, the waterfront market is home to flying fish & the original Starbucks Coffee. Enjoy the rest of the day to explore this wonderful city at your own pace. **Meals included:** Breakfast

Day 3: SEATTLE — MULTNOMAH FALLS — PORTLAND

This morning, travel south into Oregon and stop at Multnomah Falls, the secondhighest year-round waterfall in the nation, located in the scenic Columbia River Gorge. Later, enjoy a Portland City Tour to see the Columbia River, Washington Park with its famous International Rose Test Garden, Pioneer Courthouse Square, and the famous downtown food trucks. Learn how Portland has transformed from a small lumber town into a bustling big city with a lively downtown. Later, check into your hotel in the Portland area for an overnight stay & evening at leisure. **Meals included:** Breakfast

Day 4: Apr 24, 2024: PORTLAND — NEWPORT — OREGON DUNES — COOS BAY This morning, travel through the fertile Willamette Valley, containing beautiful vineyards and home to much of Oregon's agriculture. Next, visit the historic coastal town of Newport, founded in 1866. Continue to explore the magnificent Oregon Coast and visit the Oregon Dunes National Recreation Area, a unique 40-mile stretch of windswept sand, which is the largest expanse of coastal sand dunes in North America, with dunes towering up to 500 feet. Continue to Coos Bay and enjoy your evening at leisure. Meals included: Breakfast

Day 5: COOS BAY — ROGUE RIVER JETBOAT — REDWOODS NAT'L PARK — EUREKA

Early this morning, travel south along the Oregon Coast to Gold Beach & board your vessel for a Rogue River Jetboat Trip. AVERAGE TEMPERATURES & WHAT TO PACK

Average Weather

California

In August, the average high temperature in San Francisco is between 62–68 °F (17–20 °C). In Southern California, the temperature difference between the coast and inland valleys is about 23 °F (13 °C) in the summer. In Redding, the average high temperature drops from 100 °F on August 1 to 96 °F on August 31. In Palm Springs, the average high temperature drops from 109 °F at the beginning of August to 106 °F at the end.

Oregon

On the North Coast, the peak temperatures are usually around 77 °F in July and August, but temperatures can fluctuate from week to week.

Puerto Vallarta

In August, the average daily high temperature is 39 °C and the average daily low temperature is 26 °C.

What to Pack:

Packing for the Pacific Northwest in August means preparing for a mix of weather conditions. Here's a checklist to help you out:

Layered Clothing:

Lightweight Layers:

- Mornings and evenings can be chilly, even in summer, so pack a light sweater or fleece. T-shirts and Long-Sleeve Shirts: For daytime, when the weather is warmer
- Waterproof Jacket: The region can be quite rainy, even in August, so a good waterproof jacket or rain shell is essential. Opt for shoes that can handle a variety of terrains, from city streets to hiking trails. Waterproof shoes can be a plus.
- **Hat and Sunglasses**: While it might not be scorching, sunny days can still happen, so sun protection is a good idea.
- **Hiking Gear** (if you plan to hike):
 - # Hiking Boots/Shoes: Supportive and comfortable.
 - # **Backpack**: This is for carrying essentials on day hikes.
 - # Water Bottle: Staying hydrated is key.
 - **Bug Spray**: Depending on where you're going, especially in forested or marshy areas, you might encounter mosquitoes.
 - **Sunscreen:** Even if it's not hot, UV protection is important.
 - * Reusable Water Bottle: Staying hydrated is always important, especially if you're doing outdoor activities.
- Travel Adapter and Chargers: Make sure you can keep your electronics charged.
- Personal Items: Don't forget toiletries, medications, and any items you need.

The weather can vary quite a bit, so packing layers and preparing for sun and rain will keep you comfortable throughout your trip!
